Sub: Shree Siddaganga Institute of Nursing Sciences and Research center, Tumkur. To increase admission for BSc Nursing from 60 to 250 in this college.

### Preface:

in the letter read above, Chancellor, Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore is Shree Siddaganga Education Society (R) of Shree Siddaganga Institute of Nursing Sciences and Research center, B.H.Road, Tumkur-572102 Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences to increase the admission limit of B.Sc Nursing course from 60 seats to 250 seats from the year 2024-25 in this college. Article 45(2) of the University Act, 1994 has an application submitted by the institution, submitting the report of the Local Scrutiny Committee and the resolution of the Academic Council and Syndicate Committee recommending to the Government to allow the admission limit of the above course in this institution to be increased from 60 seats to 250 seats from the year 2024-25.

Scrutinize the proposal with relevant documents dated:05.12.2024 in a high powered committee meeting chaired by the Principal Secretary to Government, Department of Medical Education, as recommended by Sree Siddaganga Education Society (R) a Shree Siddaganga Institute of Nursing Sciences and Research Centre, B.H.Road, Tumkur-572102 Admission to B.Sc Nursing Course in this college from 2024-25 Govt decided to sanction increase from 60 (sixty) seats to 250 (two hundred and fifty) seats. Ordered as follows.

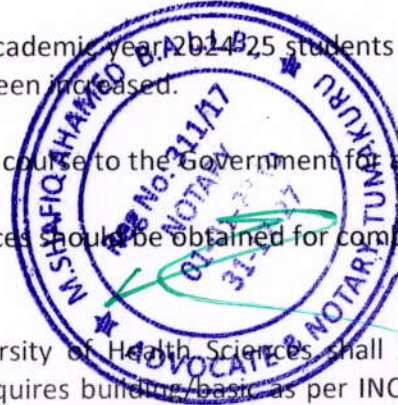

Section 45(5) of the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences Act, 1994, Sree Siddaganga Education Society (R) Shree Siddaganga Institute of Nursing Sciences and Research Centre, B.H.Road, Tumkur-572102 limits the admission to this B,Sc Nursing course from 2024-25 to 60 (sixty) seats. It has been ordered to increase the number of seats to 250 (two hundred and fifty) subject to the following conditions.

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. After issuing the government order i.e. from the academic year 2024-25 students should be admitted to the seats where the admission limit has been increased.
2. This institution shall give up 20% seats of the above course to the Government for allotment.
3. Approval of Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences should be obtained for combination of above courses.
4. The regulations prescribed by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences shall be strictly adhered to. The said Trust/Institution/Association requires building basic as per INC/Rules for starting Nursing College.



Regarding availability of facilities, the University shall ensure from the concerned authority.

5. The said institution shall admit the scheduled students only after approval of Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences. No additional student should be admitted for any reason. Violation of this will result in criminal prosecution under the Karnataka Prohibition of Admission of Students to Unrecognized and Unaffiliated Educational Institutions Act, 1991.

6. Instructions and orders issued by the State Government and the University from time to time shall be compulsorily followed.

7. The said institution shall have its own hospital within the time frame prescribed by the Government. Failure to do so will result in withdrawal of affiliation from the college.

8. Admission of students shall be as per the selection rules of candidates for admission to Karnataka Nursing, Pharmacy and Physiotherapy Courses 2003 and the specific ratio of Government Quota and Management Quota for admission to the above course as prescribed by the Government from time to time.

9. No grant or financial facilities will be provided by the Government of Karnataka to the above institution. It is subject to the condition of being a permanent unaided institution.

10. The University shall ensure from the concerned authority that the trust organization/associations are in existence.

11. The University shall ensure from the concerned authority that the trust/institution/associations/etc are not bought/sold from any other person and that there is no change in the original trustees in violation of the rules.

12. The University shall ensure from the concerned authority that its own hospital has adequate clinical facilities and bed capacity as per norms for starting the said nursing college.

13. The University shall ensure that the teaching/non-teaching staff given to start the said Nursing College have Aadhaar link attendance so as not to be duplicated in any other institution.

14. The said Nursing College was established by I.N.C. And the concerned authority shall collect from the students the fee prescribed by the rules. If not, the concerned nursing college shall withdraw the affiliation and the University shall take legal action.

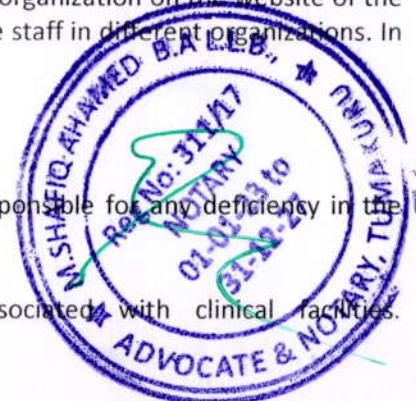
15. In case the said institution violates any of the above clauses, the affiliation currently granted to the said institution under section 48 of the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences Act, 1994 shall stand withdrawn.

16. Mandatory publication of the details of human resources in each organization on the website of the respective organizations, steps should be taken not to show the same staff in different organizations. In this regard, pay slip and Form-16 should be checked.

17. Geo-tagging of basic facilities,

18. The Site Inspection Committee and RGUHS shall be directly responsible for any deficiency in the facilities in the INC guidelines for the above institutes.

19. OPDARD located in hospitals where institutions are associated with clinical facilities. Information to be entered.



20. RGUHS shall ensure from time to time the availability of basic facilities as per INC guidelines.

21. The University shall ensure that the guidelines in the Circular/Order/Rules/Notification/Regulations/Acts issued by INC/State Government/University/KNC/other concerned authorities from time to time regarding affiliation/sanction etc. are strictly followed by the said Nursing Colleges. In case of violation or misrepresentation, the University shall initiate legal action against the concerned Colleges of Nursing, the concerned Trust/Institution/Association/etc and members of the inspection/recommendation team.
